## RESOLUTION 2017-7-10A

### A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT WATER RATES

Councilmember Gray offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

**WHEREAS**, Sections 53.60, 53.61 and 53.62 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Flushing provides that water rates shall be set by resolution of the Flushing City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the Flushing City Council desires to establish water rates effective July 1, 2017;

**WHEREAS**, the Genesee County Drain Commissioner Water and Waste Division has increased monthly meter equivalent charges for whole sale water customers in June 2017;

**WHEREAS**, the monthly meter equivalent charge for the City of Flushing was \$4,618 (\$55,416) and will be raised to \$20,000 (\$240,000) with the possibility of increasing to \$23,000 (\$276,000) by the Genesee County Drain Commissioner Water and Waste Division.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Flushing City Council, as provided for in Sections 53.60, 53.61 and 53.62 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Flushing, hereby establishes the following schedule of water rates:

Operating, Debt and Maintenance Charge per Unit (Readiness to Serve)	\$75.00/quarter
Water Usage and direct supplies per unit (Commodity Charge)	\$6.10/1,000 gallons

#### Outside Water Meters


Where an additional meter has been installed by the city pursuant to Section 52.110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Flushing to meter outside water usage, the water usage measured by such additional meter shall be read in combination with the other meter serving said premises and the water charges calculated on the total usage of both meters taken as one.


Water Used During Construction - \$230.86 per quarter

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, those residents who, in the judgment of the City Clerk by reason of poverty, are unable to contribute to the public charges are eligible for exemption of the operating and maintenance and debt charge portion of the water bill. The Federal Poverty Income Standards as published by the Bureau of the Census will be used to determine eligibility. Residents filing a claim must annual present federal and state income tax returns to the City Clerk. Residents have a right to appeal the determination to the City Manager.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that said rates shall be in effect on July 1, 2017.
